

Federal Bonding Program

Federal Bonding is provided by the Pennsylvania Department of Labor & Industry free of charge for six (6) months to employers willing to take a chance by hiring individuals who are not commercially bondable.

Bonding Coverage

Bonds are available in increments of \$5,000, with the maximum amount of \$25,000. Coverage is based on estimated risk of financial loss resulting from theft, larceny, embezzlement, or fraud committed by the covered individual, at one time during the specified six-month period.

Individuals eligible for Federal Bonding include:

- Ex-offenders, including anyone with a record of arrest, conviction or imprisonment.
- Those with a poor financial credit history or who have declared bankruptcy.
- Ex-addicts with history of alcohol or drug abuse.
- Those that have been dishonorably discharged from the Armed Forces.
- Persons lacking a work history from low-income families, including disadvantaged youth.
