

ABOUT THE ALLENTOWN SCHOOL DISTRICT FOUNDATION

Founded in 2009, the Foundation was established by some wonderful people who cared about the future of the Allentown School District and its students. Since then, we have raised more than \$3.5 million dollars to fund programs for Allentown's school children, providing resources directly to teachers and students. Our programs and partnerships support our mission of providing enriched educational programming throughout ASD's 25 educational buildings. As the district continues to find solutions to myriad challenges, both academic and financial, the Foundation's Board of Directors recognizes the critical need to sustain its mission: to encourage, promote, support and fund innovative educational experiences for our students. The diverse programs the Foundation provides in science, the performing arts, literacy and many others uniquely fill the void for some programs that have been eliminated because of budget cutbacks or offer new opportunities in learning. In fact, in 2017-2018, 8,598 students participated in programs supported by the Foundation; in 2018-2019, 10,726 students were involved in almost 20 programs offered and sponsored by the Foundation.

The Foundation is funded solely through gifts and grants. All positions are considered part-time, without benefits.
