Two Career Paths A & B We offer two paths to aspire for Director of Dining:

- Path A through dining services
- Path B through culinary services

Director of Dining

(Paths A & B) Manages the entire dining department. Must be at least 18 years old and have a high school or GED diploma (culinary or hospitality degree preferred) and at least three years of experience in the food service industry in a supervisory role.

Executive Chef

(Path B) Develops menus and manages the kitchen staff. Must be at least 18 years old and have a high school or GED diploma (culinary degree preferred), Culinary Certification (as needed) and four years of cooking, scheduling and inventory experience. Supervisory experience preferred.

Culinary Associate (Path B) Entry level or experienced cook. Must be at least 18 years old and have a high school or GED diploma, Culinary Certification (as needed) and at least one year of dining room experience.

Dining Room Manager (Path A) Manages and coordinates the entire dining room operation. Must be at least 18 years old and have a high school or GED diploma, Culinary Certification (as needed) and two years of cooking experience. Supervisory experience preferred.

Dining Room Coordinator (Path A) Manages the entire dining room staff. Must be at least 18 years old and have a high school or GED diploma, Culinary Certification (as needed) and some training/leadership experience. Supervisory experience with advanced level.

Dining Associate

(Path A) Serves residents meals. Must be at least 16 years old and will train. Must complete company on-boarding. Shift Leader with advanced level.
