Web Application
Developer

Must be an experienced web application developer and be able to jump-start a new application development platform. Bachelor's degree in related field such as data and analysis, or business intelligence from an accredited institution. Experience facilitating application development and IT project and services delivery. Annual salary range: \$50,454 - \$68,498.



Business Intelligence
Analyst

Responsible for liaising between technical administrative, and faculty, staff members for the formulation and documentation of functional and business requirements covering workflow, technology services delivery. Annual salary range: \$57,000 - \$72,140.



Database
Administrator

Responsible for administration of the college's operating environment and supplementary systems. Responsible for providing technical assistance to clients. Associate degree or other equivalent certification/experience required. Knowledge of current MS Windows operating systems. Prior experience with the support of a mid-range UNIX platform. Certification in Windows server based operating systems. Knowledge of Oracle or SQL. Knowledge of HP UX preferred. Annual salary range: \$50,454 - \$68,498.
