Minimum of five years' experience in supervision/management and working with young children in special and or early childhood education. Knowledge of typical infant/toddler/preschool/school age development and developmental disabilities. Must meet all criteria required by licensing regulations and quality standards.



Kindergarten Teacher A Bachelor's Degree in Early Childhood Education, Elementary Education, or a related field with ECE credits is required. Teaching Certification for Pennsylvania is required. Two years' experience working with young children in special education and/or early childhood education. Knowledge of typical infant/toddler/preschool development and developmental disabilities. Must have the ability to lift up to 50 lbs. Standing, sitting, lifting and walking are required daily.
